You realize that the Bill was published on Friday and seven days have not yet elapsed and because of the urgency of this bill we should shorten the period which it was supposed to go through so that we dispense with this bill today because it is a special sitting and we might not be having any other time if we will have to wait for seven days to elapse. I beg this honourable House that we adopt that we shorten the time and we allow the bill to go through this first reading as per our Standing Order 121, and I beg honourable Mosonik to second me.
