Hon. Speaker: Leader of the Majority.

Hon. J. Kirui: Thank you very much honourable Speaker for this opportunity; aware that I am supposed to move a motion on reconstitution of members of different committees because of the fact that when we approve our standing orders the members of committees was reduced from nine to seven. There is a new committee that is the implementation committee and there was an increase of the membership of the Budget and Appropriation. However, honourable Speaker, I want to really request through your chair we had to finalize the list and I was waiting for leader of minority so that we are in concurrence before I formally table, and honourable Speaker, I also request that this be considered in the House Business Committee before it goes to the House business so that the issue of balancing and other issues would actually be factored in because we want the list to be as inclusive as possible, to be as fair as possible, and to be objective as possible.
