THAT, aware that County Government under section 36(2) of the Urban Areas and Cities Act 2011 is required to initiate an integrated urban planning process that will ensure that our markets and urban centres are upgraded into towns and municipalities; also aware that in order to upgrade those market centres into such towns and municipalities there must be inter alia demonstrable economic, functional and financial viability, the existence of an integrated development plan and the capacity to effectively and efficiently deliver essential services to its residents; also aware that the existence of infrastructural facilities, including but not limited to roads, street lighting, refuse disposal mechanisms, health facilities, markets, fire stations and an adequate capacity for disaster management will encourage investments and growth of such markets and urban centres; deeply concerned that lack of these essential infrastructural facilities has retarded growth of these markets and urban centres within our County; this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee to develop infrastructure in at least two markets in every ward so as to enable them to be upgraded into towns and municipalities.

STATEMENTS: WEDNESDAY, MARCH 28th 2018 AT 2.30 P.M

1. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Leonard Ngeny on 27th February, 2018 from the **Chairperson Committee on Education, Youths and Sports** on the awarding of tenders to youths, women and persons with disabilities by the County Government. The Hon. Member wanted to be specifically informed on the following;
 - i. The number and list of tenders which have been awarded to youths by the County Government in the current financial year (FY 2017/2018).
 - ii. The criteria used by the County Government in identifying tenders to be awarded to the Youths.
 - iii. The specific companies and other business entities which have been awarded tenders by the County Government over the said period.

2. Comprehensive statement sought on 6th March, 2017 by Hon. Charles Langat from the **Chairperson Committee on Education, Youth and Sports** on the status of the following Vocational and Technical (Polytechnics) Centers situated within Boito Ward;
 1. Kaptebengwet Vocational Training Centre.
 2. Kaptien Vocational Training Centre.
 3. Kapsir Vocational Training Centre.
 4. Boito Vocational Training Centre.

The Hon. Member wanted clarifications on the following;

- a) What is the total financial allocation for each of the Vocational Centre since the inception of the county government up to date?
 - b) What is the total number of both teaching and non-teaching staff employed and/or seconded to each of the vocational centers?
 - c) What are the key equipment acquired and/or infrastructural installations for each of the vocational centers?
 - d) What strategies has the county government put in place to ensure maximum utilization of these vocational centers so as to facilitate acquisition of proper occupational trade skills and to become centers of innovation, research and development?
 - e) Does the county government have a policy or legislative framework to provide for the establishment, governance and regulation of Vocational and Technical (Polytechnics) Centers including their registration and management and for such connected purposes?
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3. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Robert Serbai on 7th March, 2018 from the **Chairperson Committee on Budget and Appropriation** on the debts and pending Bills owed by the County Government. The Hon. Member wanted to be specifically informed on the following;
 - a) Total debts owed to suppliers and Contractors by the County Government from the Financial year 2013/2014 to 2016/2017.
 - b) How much money was borrowed by the County Government from financial institutions as loans and overdrafts from the Financial year 2013/2014 to 2016/2017.
 - c) Whether requisite approvals were sought by the County Executive before the money was borrowed.

- d) Whether the amount borrowed has been fully repaid.
4. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Robert Serbai on 7th March, 2018 from the **Chairperson Committee on Education, Youths and Sports** on the construction of Early Childhood Education (ECD) Centres by the County Government. The Hon. Member wanted to be specifically informed on the following;
- a) The total funding that the County Government has used in the construction of ECD centres in the Financial Years 2014/2015, 2015/2016 and 2016/2017
 - b) The cost of each ECD centre that was constructed over the said period of time.
 - c) The number of ECD centres per ward that have been constructed and their current status in the above stated financial years.
