1. Comprehensive sought by Hon. Alfred Langat on 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 statement from the chairperson **Committee on Labour and Public Service** on the recent recruitment of health officers. The chairperson should indicate the;
  - i. How many applicants have been issued with appointments
  - ii. The list of the names of those recruited, their positions and their place of origin i.e county and the wards they come from
  - iii. What criteria did the County Public Service Board use during the recruitment process of health officers
  - iv. What is the fate of those who are/were hired on contractual basis

2. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Robert Langat on 2<sup>nd</sup> May, 2018 from the Chairperson Committee on Health and Sanitation concerning acquisition of ambulance services by the County Government. The Hon. Member wished to be specifically informed on the following;
