4. STATEMENTS

1. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 30th August, 2016 from Chairperson, Committee on Labour and Public Service on the fate of ECD assistants employed by the County Government. In particular, the chairperson should inform on the following;
 - a. Why the ECD assistants (recruited) have not received confirmation letters yet they have passed through the required employment procedures?
 - b. What is the department's plan towards the issuance of confirmation letters?

 - iii. Provide a list of roads to be constructed/maintained or the ones already constructed/maintained from tea cess revenue in the F.Y. 2016/17The statement was committed to the committee on Budget and Appropriation which was given until 7th February 2017 to respond.
