4. NOTICE OF MOTION

The following notice of motion was given by Hon. Joseah Chepkwony:-

THAT, aware that one of the functions devolved under Part 2 of the fourth schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 is that of agriculture including crop and animal husbandry; also aware that irrigation programmes will boost agricultural activities and livelihoods of many families in the County; further aware that some parts of Bomet county have potential to undertake irrigation due to availability of water, deeply concerned that there are some irrigation programmes including Nogirwet Irrigation Scheme which have been abandoned; this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee to prioritize supporting and funding of irrigation programmes in the County.
