#### **4. COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR**

Hon. Speaker gave the following communication from the Chair,  
“Hon. Members, I received a communication from the Governor H.E Dr. Joyce Laboso via a letter dated 13<sup>th</sup> October 2017 but received by my office on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2017 inviting members to submit to her office two (2) priority Early Childhood Education (ECDE) classrooms and two (2) priority roads for repair on or before 27<sup>th</sup> of October 2017.

This was a follow up on what the Governor discussed with the members during the induction retreat of the new County Assembly members where she had urged members to help her office in identifying a priority list of schools in each Ward for construction of new ECDE classrooms and roads for repair.

Attached to the communication is a guideline that has been developed by the office of the Governor to help the office in rolling out the implementation of the program.

Hon. Members, in the communication, the office of the Governor also intends to conduct a comprehensive audit of the ECDE projects that were done by the previous County Government so as to determine the appropriate actions necessary to complete all the stalled projects in a responsible manner.”
