The following Notice of Motion was given by Hon. Robert Serbai;

THAT, aware that County health services is one of the devolved functions under Part 2 of the fourth schedule to the Constitution of Kenya 2010; also aware that section 116(1) of the Public Finance Management Act 2012 empowers the Executive Committee Member for finance to establish other public funds with the approval of the County Executive Committee and the County Assembly; further aware that there has been rampant cases of cancer, diabetes and heart related problems in our County; deeply concerned that the cost of treatment for these cases is so high that most of our residents don't afford given their modest living; this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee once established to establish a fund to help people with cases of cancer, diabetes and heart related problems in our County

6. **NOTICE OF MOTION**

The following Notice of Motion was given by Hon. Alfred Langat;

THAT, aware that one of the functions devolved under Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution of Kenya 2010 is that of County transport including county roads; also aware the County Assembly allocated a total of KES 446,156,244 in the approved 2017/2018 Medium Term Expenditure Framework for construction of roads and bridges; also further aware that a number of roads in Singorwet Ward including but not limited to Cheptuiyet –Kapkoita road, Chepkurbet-Motiret Road, Chepkitach-Kaptembwo Road, Aisaik-Singorwet Road, Salaik-Kitoben Road and Suswondo-Masese Road are in pathetic state; Deeply concerned that the residents have experienced a myriad of challenges in transporting their produce to tea and milk collection centers; this County assembly urges the County executive Committee once constituted to include the construction of the said roads in the County Integrated Development Plan, the 2017/2018 Annual Development Plan and to urgently intervene and construct the said roads
