**8\* MOTION** (Hon. Patrick Chepkwony)

**THAT** aware that trade regulation and development including co-operative societies is one of the functions of the devolved units of Government; also aware that Article 55 of the Constitution states that the state shall take measures including affirmative action programmes to ensure that the youth have opportunities to associate, be represented and participate in political, social, economic and other spheres of life; deeply concerned that the youth of this County should be encouraged to form Savings and Credits Co-operative societies(SACCOS) by the County Government; this County assembly urges the County Government of Bomet to assist the youth by facilitating the registration of SACCOS for the youth so as to enhance their economic growth.

**9\* MOTION** (Hon. Julius Korir)

**THAT** aware that Article 73(1)(a)(iv) of the Constitution states that the authority assigned to a state officer is a public trust to be exercised in a manner that promotes public confidence in the integrity of the office; also aware that Article 73(2) of the Constitution elaborates the principles of leadership which include accountability of decisions to the public for decisions and actions; also aware that Article 201 of the Constitution states that there shall be openness and accountability in financial matters and that public money shall be used in a prudent and responsible way; also aware that Article 229(5) mandates the Auditor General to audit and report on the accounts of any entity funded from public funds and to submit the same to Parliament for adoption and appropriate action; also aware that under Article 96 of the Constitution the Senate represents the counties and serves to protect the interest of the counties and their governments and that pursuant to article 125 of the Constitution, the Senate

has power to summon any person to appear before it for the purpose of giving evidence or providing information; also aware that the Senate Committee on Public Account has on diverse occasions invited the Governor of Bomet County to appear before it to explain audit queries raised by the report of the Auditor General concerning the utilization of public funds in Bomet County but has failed to honour those invitations citing that it should be referred to junior officers; further aware that the Senate passed a motion directing the controller of budget to withhold any disbursements to Bomet County until such a time that the Governor chooses to appear before the Senate Committee on public accounts; Deeply concerned that the non-compliance on the part of the Governor shall hurt the County's economy and completely paralyse operations within the County and that the image of Bomet County has been brought into disrepute; this House urges the Governor of Bomet County to immediately honour summons by the Senate to pave way for funds to be released to the County.
