THAT aware that Article 36(1) of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, provides that every person has the right to freedom of association, which includes the right to form, join or participate in the activities of any kind; also aware that part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution provides that one of the functions of the County governments is trade development and regulation including co-operative societies; further aware that one of the objects of devolution as stipulated in Article 174 of the Constitution is to promote social and economic development and the provision of proximate, easily accessible services throughout Kenya; deeply concerned that the residents of this County who want their groups registered and issued with group registration certificates are currently facing challenges of both delay and failure to ascertain whether registration is a role of the County or National Government; this House urges the County Government of Bomet to urgently own the responsibility of registration of groups so as to enable the residents access public funds including but not limited to the recently approved County Enterprise Development Fund, Youth Enterprise Fund and the Uwezo Fund.
