8***MOTION** (Hon. Aurelia Chepkirui)

THAT, aware that Article 55 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 provides that the state shall take measures, including affirmative action programmes to ensure that the youth access relevant education and training; also aware that the approved 2014/2015 Financial Year budget has an allocation of Kenya Shillings **5,500, 000** for youth training and development; further aware that the national government has released up to a tune of 6 billion Kenya shillings towards the *uwezo* fund and that this County assembly approved the County Enterprise Development Fund(CED) Policy Sessional Paper N0.3 of 2014; deeply concerned that the youth might not benefit from these funds if they are not given the requisite training and empowerment on matters to do with entrepreneurship; this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee of Bomet to initiate a youth training and empowerment programme to impart our youths with entrepreneurship skills.
