PROCEDURAL MOTION

Leader of Majority (Hon. P. Kirui): Hon. Speaker I beg to move a Procedural Motion that pursuant to standing order 28(4) this County Assembly resolve to adjourn today Wednesday 15th March to Tuesday 21st March 2023 at 2.30 p.m.

Hon. Speaker this adjournment is to enable members to work on the business in their committees. The Members also have a lot to work on in their wards.
