

PROCEDURAL MOTION

Hon. Speaker (Hon. N. Mutai): Hon. Chepkwony.

Hon. J. Chepkwony: Thank you Hon. Speaker. I rise to move a Procedural Motion that pursuant to Standing Order 28(3) this County Assembly adjourns from today Wednesday 18th May 2022 to Tuesday 7th June 2022 in accordance with the County Assembly calendar regular session for 2022. Mr. Speaker as this was tabled in this House and this provision was factored in that calendar and we are supposed to have a recess. We need to have a reunion with our constituents. Hon. Speaker, I wish to request the majority Whip to second.

Hon. Speaker (Hon. N. Mutai): Hon. Davis.

Hon. D. Kipkirui: Thank you Hon. Speaker. I wish to second the motion moved by the Leader of the Majority. At the beginning of this session, this House passed the Calendar which indicates that we should proceed on a short recess from tomorrow. The campaigns are yet to start. Hon. Speaker, I second and support the motion and I request your table that since we have a lot of pending businesses, I wish that you can allow these Hon. Members to go out and deliberate on the pending businesses. We are remaining with a short time. Hon. Speaker I support and second.

Hon. R. Serbai: Mr. Speaker I support the motion. As we proceed to this short recess we have a lot of work before us. Through your Chair we need to do what is required of us. In Public Accounts and Investments Committee we have a lot of reports that we need to give responses to, also the Budget and Appropriation committee which we were given 30 days. We are approaching

Hon. R. Serbai: Hon. Speaker my point of order is simple, just to thank you for the language you are using to console the members by using the word *sine die* as if they are not going home.

Hon. Speaker (Hon. N. Mutai): Hon. Kirui.

Hon. L. Kirui: Hon. Speaker, I just want to ask whether the member is in order by interpreting the meaning of *sine die* to mean going home slowly. I believe it means if anything happen the Assembly will still be active.

Hon. Speaker (Hon. N. Mutai): Hon. Serbai.

Hon. R. Serbai: Hon. Speaker, it was only a way of thanking you for the soft language you are using. I know the meaning of *sine die*. I do not anticipate anything bad to happen. For those who are coming, I wish them all the best. May those who are coming elect you to be the Speaker of this Assembly.

Hon. Speaker (Hon. N. Mutai): Thank you Hon. Serbai. I believe when we come back we will be dealing with the Budget and Appropriation for the next financial year. Thank you so much Members
