#### PRAYERS

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Hon Members I welcome the Students from Starlight academy Bomet Central and their teachers.

**Hon. W. Kiprotich (Chepchas Ward, UDA):** hon Speaker there was a petition I brought to this Assembly on the plight of the people of Chepchas during the colonial period and precolonial time. It was committed to lands housing and urban planning and it status should be looked into so that petitioners can get answers. I also join you in welcoming the students who have joined us.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Chair of the committee do you have any information about the petition?

**Hon. B. Langat (Kembu Ward, UDA):** Hon Speaker I am not the chair but a member to the committee and hon Busienei who is the chair is almost in.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Kindly inform the Assembly on the status of the petition

**Hon. B. Langat (Kembu Ward, UDA):** Hon speaker we are doing investigation on the petition and we will give the status next week

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Which date

**Hon. B. Langat (Kembu Ward):** 7<sup>th</sup> of next month

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** The 30days we gave has elapsed

*Hon Changmorik rose on a pint of order*

**Hon. S. Changmorik:** Hon Speaker the member is not sure of what he is saying. Next week should be around 15<sup>th</sup>. Let him clarify.

**Hon. B. Langat (Kembu Ward, UDA):** Hon Speaker I think the question asked by Hon Wesley belongs to the last assembly. As at now we are dealing with what is at hand.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** I can see the chair is with us. Hon Busienei there was a petition which was raised by Hon Kiprotich given to the Second Assembly. We want to know the status of the petition.

**Hon. D. Busienei Chemagel Ward, UDA):** Mr. Speaker we had discussed in our meeting, as at now we do not have CEC and CO for lands housing and urban planning. We are requesting for 2weeks so that we can give a comprehensive statement.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Do you have a specific date?

**Hon. D. Busienei (Chemagel Ward, UDA):** By the end of this month

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Hon member the Assembly adjourns on 1<sup>st</sup> Dec.

**Hon. D. Busienei (Chemagel Ward, UDA):** Hon Speaker by 29<sup>th</sup> we shall have the CO because we do not have CEC for now.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** 29<sup>th</sup> will be Tuesday? Table office kindly note that.

**Hon. W. Kiprotich (Chepchabas Ward, UDA):** Hon Speaker I said earlier that there is no one to blame. The petition is not easy because it involves land. Time lapsed in the Second Assembly and the committee can take up the matter. I wanted to bring to the attention of this Assembly that there is a petition whose details has not be dealt with.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Hon Busienei it will prudent if you meet with the Member from the affected area then give us the status

**Hon. D. Busienei (Chemagel Ward, UDA):** Obliged Mr. Speaker.

**Hon. C. Langat (Boito Ward, UDA):** Hon speaker, with your permission, I rise to seek the status of my on disposal of wastes. You had given a timeline of 30 days and its almost elapsing and I haven't gotten the answer.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Is that under water and sanitation?

**Hon. C. Langat (Boito Ward, UDA):** Urban Planning.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Hon. Busienei kindly gives the status of the statement.

**Hon. D. Busienei (Chemagel Ward, UDA):** Mr. Speaker, I have similar answer to the previous one. For now we don't have sub standing CEC and CO for urban and we would like to work on the issue immediately we get one.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Can't we use the CEC and the CO who are present now because they are aware of the pending matter?

**Hon. D. Busienei (Chemagel Ward, UDA):** We had taken up the matter to the CEC who is in now and he was saying we give him time so that he gets the new one and give us the information. We have already taken up the matter to the CEC. Thank you.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** I have some communication, the Assembly committee to meet immediately after this session in my office. We would therefore adjourn.

**Hon. L. Rotich (Deputy Speaker):** Hon speaker, I will request that before the adjournment or whatever business ahead of us, I would like to also acknowledge the presence of the student and teachers from my ward Sky light academy who have visited us. I want tell them that they are highly welcome to learn and have an eye on what's going on in the assembly. I also want to wish the standard 8 and grade six candidates all the best as they prepare to sit for the KCPE examinations. Welcome.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Thank you hon. member. That was an insight and fir the teachers, the MCA from your area are also the deputy speaker at this great Assembly. Thank you.

**Hon. S. Changmorik (Longisa Ward, UDA):** Thank you hon. speaker let me take this opportunity to welcome the students and teachers to this Assembly. This one of the unit of the county government and an oversight body. We are happy that you have come here to learn and we wish you the best in your studies and congratulate the teachers for the work they are doing. This

Assembly represents 25 wards of this county and we are there for you. We wish you well in your exams and for the director we appreciate him, take our greeting to him and tell him the assembly appreciates the work he is doing. Thank you.

**Hon. Speaker (C. Korir):** Thank you very much. I don't know whether there's anybody who still wants to contribute. I want to welcome back hon. J.K who was away, we are happy to see you. That committee has given their email and if you have anything that you feel it should be changed in the education system, not necessarily on the ones the county is involved even beyond as long as it touches on education. So you have a platform to participate. The chairman of Education committee was there. We are lucky to have the teachers today. You can contribute so that it can be debated in this Assembly and forwarded to that committee. That presidential task force for education in Kenya was headed by Prof. Moth and Dr. Githinji. Second is to wish you all the best. The pupils who are in grade 6 and those who are doing KCPE, all the best in your exams. To the members, it's to inform you that the bank guarantee is ready. You just have to indicate which make of the vehicle that you want the dealer and the cost. It's actually at the platform have it in writing and hand over to the deputy speaker so that it can be handed over to the executive. By next week you should all be having machines. Thank you. I so then direct that we adjourn this session up to Tomorrow 9:30 in the morning.
