1. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Wesley Kiprotich on 17th April, 2018 from the chairperson Committee on Labour and Public Service concerning the current status of employment in the County Public Service. The chairperson should indicate;
 - a) The total number of employees in the County Public Service indicating their names, designations and the wards they come from
 - b) The salary scale of each employee
 - c) Their terms of employment whether contractual or permanent; and
 - d) The time they were first employed in the County Public Service
