QUESTIONS AND STATEMENTS

1. Question sought by **Hon. Josphat Kipkirui** on **2nd March, 2023** on revenue collection in the County. In reply, the chairperson, Committee on Finance and Economic Planning was required to give a response on the following:-
 - a) The total number of revenue officers in the County and the nature of employment.
 - b) The measures that the relevant department has put in place to ensure that the required number of officers are recruited.
 - c) The total revenue collected by the County Government between 1st July, 2022 and 28th February, 2023.
 - d) The current status of automation of revenue collection in the County.
 - e) The measures put in place by the relevant department to explore and
2. Question by **Hon Charles Langat** on **13th October, 2022** concerning the status of waste disposal in all the factories, educational institutions, hospitals and residential buildings in Bomet County was due. The County Executive Committee Member in charge of Lands, Urban Planning and Housing was required to:-
 - (1) Provide a comprehensive report on the status of compliance with the National Environmental Management Authority (NEMA) rules and regulations by the said facilities;
 - (2) State the steps that the department has undertaken or is planning to undertake to ensure compliance with the said rules and regulations if number one above is in the negative.
 - (3) Indicate whether the department has qualified personnel who in conjunction with NEMA would ensure compliance;
 - (4) State whether there are designated places of waste disposal in the stated facilities;
 - (5) State whether the department has received any complaints from the members of the public concerning the status of waste disposal in any of the stated facilities
