THAT aware that Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution 2010 mandates the County Government to license and regulate the establishment of child care facilities including but not limited to children's home; Also aware that Article 53(1) (d) of the Constitution provides that every child has a right to be protected from abuse, neglect, all forms of violence, inhuman treatment and punishment; Further aware that the Childrens Act provides for the establishment of Charitable Children's Institutions upon fulfillment of certain conditions; Further aware of the recent media expose dubbed '**preying missionaries**' on the suspected molestation, rape and abuse of children at Dows Children's home at Boito within Konoin Sub County; deeply concerned that there could be other serious

unreported malpractices in children homes established in the county and that children continue to suffer in the very hands of those that were mandated to care for them; this County Assembly urges the County Government of Bomet to establish a policy framework to provide for the registration, licensing and periodic inspection of child care facilities within the county.
