1. Statement sought by Hon. John Molel on 8th June, 2016 from the chairperson Committee on Lands, Housing and Urban Planning concerning the waste disposal by private investors in Chepilat Market centre in Rongena/Manaret Ward. In particular, the Hon. Member wished to be informed on:
 - i. Whether the chairperson is aware that the said investors are releasing untreated affluent waste from their residential houses to mogoiwek and Mabwaita rivers which are sources of water for domestic use by residents of Mabwaita and Mogoiwet Villages?
 - ii. What the department of Housing and Urban Planning is doing to curb the menace?

2. Statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 17th May, 2016 from the chairperson Committee on Education, Youth and Sports concerning the allocation of bursary to needy students in day schools in Siongiroi ward. The Hon. Member wished to be informed on why the students failed to receive Ksh 7,500 each during the 2014/15 and 2015/16 financial years yet there were budgetary allocations of Ksh. 70,000,000 under 26404402 and 20,000,000 under vote 26401101 respectively and a policy to that effect
