4. STATEMENTS

The following statements were due;

- 1) Comprehensive sought by Hon. Haron Kirui statement from the Chairperson Committee on Energy, Environment, Water & Natural Resources on the funding of Mogombet Water Project by the County Government. The Hon. Member wished to be specifically informed on the following;
 - a) The total funding that the County Government has extended to Mogombet Water Project to date.
 - b) The specific work which was financed by the County Government in the water project.
 - c) The name of the contractor engaged in the work financed by the County Government in the water project.
 - d) The reason as to why the weir which had been scheduled to be constructed has not been completed to date.

The Chairperson responded to the statement, however, it was not satisfactory and the Hon. Speaker directed the Committee to do a comprehensive report on the stamen and table a report in the County Assembly within a period of 21 days.

- 2) Statement sought by Hon. from the Chairperson Committee on Energy, Environment, Water and Natural Resources concerning Bomet Water Company. The Hon. Member wished to be specifically informed on the following;

- a) How much money was allocated to the company during the 2013/2014, 2014/2015, 2015/2016, 2016/2017 and 2017/2018 Financial Years.
- b) Why were the funds allocated to the Company yet it has never been declared as a County entity?
- c) Why has the company not submitted their audited accounts to this County Assembly as required under Article 229(7) of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 yet the County funds its operations?

The committee was given 7 more days to give a response on the statement.

- 3) Comprehensive statement from the Chairperson Committee on Budget and Appropriation on the debts and pending Bills owed by the County Government. The Hon. Member wanted to be specifically informed on the following;
 - a) Total debts owed to suppliers and Contractors by the County Government from the Financial year 2013/2014 to 2016/2017.
 - b) How much money was borrowed by the County Government from financial institutions as loans and overdrafts from the Financial year 2013/2014 to 2016/2017.
 - c) Whether requisite approvals were sought by the County Executive before the money was borrowed.
 - d) Whether the amount borrowed has been fully repaid.

The Chairperson issued a response to the statement. Upon further deliberations, the Hon. Speaker directed the Committee to undertake further investigation and come up with a comprehensive report touching on the entire county and including actionable recommendations within 21 days.
