4. COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR

The Speaker read a letter from the Majority Whip concerning the United Republican Party Group meeting on 8th August 2016 where Hon. Josphat Kirui was removed as the Leader of Majority. He also read a letter from the Chairman URP Bomet Branch concerning the appointment of Hon. Samwel Bor as the acting Leader of Majority and Hon. Julius Korir as the acting Deputy Leader of Majority subject to confirmation of the same on 22nd August 2016. The Speaker then swore in Hon. Samwel Bor as the acting Leader of Majority and the County Assembly Service Board Vice Chairperson.

5. ELECTION OF THE DEPUTY SPEAKER

The Speaker indicated that the procedure for the election of the Speaker shall with necessary modifications apply to the election of the Deputy Speaker. He then read out the procedure for elections of the Speaker. The members who qualified were given a chance to convince the members to vote for them;

1. Hon. Benard Ngeno withdrew from vying and declared support for Hon. Samson Towett;
2. Hon. Leonard Kirui;
3. Hon. Sammy kirui;
4. Hon. Samson Towett;

The Speaker then directed the Clerk to confirm that the ballot box was empty.

The Clerk then called the names of the honourable members present;

At the Close of the voting; the Clerk then counted the votes and the results were as follows;

1. Hon. Sammy Kirui-22 votes

2. Hon.Samson Towett-10 votes
3. Hon.Leonard Kirui-2 votes

No candidate garnered the required two-thirds majority and a second election was then called between the first two candidates, that is; Hon. Sammy Kirui and Hon.Samson Towett.

The Clerk then again called the names of the members present and they voted again;

The following were the results of the second election;

1. Hon.Sammy Kirui-21 votes
2. Hon.Samson Towett- 13 votes

The Speaker then declared Hon. Sammy Kirui as the elected Deputy Speaker having garnered a simple majority of the votes.
