#### **4. NOTICE OF MOTION (HON. JOSEPH KELONG)**

**THAT**, aware that agriculture ,including crop and animal husbandry, is a devolved function under part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010; also aware that most farmers in Bomet County do livestock farming; also aware that East Coast Fever (ECF) is one of the diseases that poses a great risk and challenge to most livestock farmers and that the most effective way to control it is by vaccination; further aware that livestock vaccines especially for East Coast Fever disease are too costly and beyond the reach of most farmers ; also aware that most farmers do struggle to vaccinate their livestock with little or no support from the county government; deeply concerned that livestock farmers continue to lose their livestock through preventable diseases such as East Coast fever; this Assembly urges the County Government to consider subsidizing the cost of livestock vaccines ,in particular vaccines for East Coast Fever (ECF).

#### **5. STATEMENTS**

The following statement was sought;

A comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Davis Kipkirui from the Chairperson Committee on Energy, Environment, Water and Natural Resources concerning Chemosit Water Project in Longisa Ward. In particular, he sought to be informed on: -

1. The whereabouts of the water pump which was stationed at the above stated water project
2. The reason why the said water pump was taken from the water project
3. The current condition of the said water pump
4. The reason why the employee who was manning equipment stationed at Chemosit Water Project was dismissed by the County Government immediately after the water pump had been taken.
5. The steps that the relevant department has taken to assist the affected residents.

The Hon. Deputy Speaker directed the Committee on Water, Energy, Environment and Natural Resources to respond within 21 days.
