5. NOTICE OF MOTION (Hon. Bency Too)

THAT, pursuant to Section 8 of the Bomet County Public Appointments (Assembly Approval) Act, 2014 and Standing Order 188(1) (4), this County Assembly adopts the Report of the Committee on Appointment on the vetting of Mrs. Beatrice Chepkorir Tonui, laid on the table of the County Assembly on 15th November, 2016 and rejects the appointment of Mrs. Beatrice Chepkorir Tonui as the County Executive Committee Member for Agribusiness, Cooperatives and Marketing.

6. STATEMENTS

1. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Julius Korir on 22nd June, 2016 from the Chairperson Labour and Public Service Committee concerning the office of the acting County Secretary. In the statement the Chairperson should indicate whether the acting County Secretary Mr. Kilelson Mutai meets the requirements provided under section 44(2) of the County Governments Act 2012 as required under section 64 of the County Governments Act 2012

The statement was committed to the Committee on Labour and Public Service (No 63)

The answer given was satisfactory.

2. Statement sought by Hon. Robert Serbai on 6th July, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Energy, Environment, Water and Natural Resources regarding Taboino and Cheptalal water projects.

In the Statement, the Chairperson should state;

1. How much Money was allocated to each of the projects;
2. How much has been spent on each of the projects;
3. The current status of the projects and how many residents will each of them serve when completed?

3. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Evaline Chepkemai on 13th July, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Health and Sanitation. In particular, the Hon. Member wished to be informed on the following issues;

- a) Why Kitaima and Kaplelgin dispensaries have not received any financial support since the inception of the County Government?
- b) Why has Kapkoros Health Centre not been upgraded?

4. Statement sought by Hon. Josphat Kirui on 25th October, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Roads, Transport and Public Works concerning the construction of the following roads in Ndaraweta Ward;

- (a) Teganda Shopping Centre- Tea Zone-1.7 K.m
- (b) Tea zone- Nyongores- 2.5 Km
- (c) Kiptogoch road
- (d) Mogoiywet-Kiptenden Road

In the statement, the Chairperson should state;

- (a) Whether he is aware that the said roads have not even been murramed despite the contrary information given in the implementation status report that the same have been completed;
- (b) The fate of the fuel levy fund which was supposed to be utilized in the repair of Sonokwek Road during the 2015/16 Financial Year yet the said funds have not been disbursed and the financial year has already lapsed.

The statement was committed to the Committee on Roads, Transport and Public Works (No 74)

5. Comprehensive statement sought on 3rd August, 2016 by Hon. John Chepkwony from the Chairperson Committee on Health and Sanitation concerning the stalled Labotiet Dispensary in Chebunyo Ward. In the statement, the Chairperson should;

- a) Explain why the dispensary which was funded during the 2013/14 financial year has stalled for a long time
- b) Indicate the amount of money that had been allocated to the project
- c) State the time frame within which the project was supposed to be completed
- d) Indicate the amount of money that has already been spent

- e) Explain why the supplier of the said project has not been paid for the materials already supplied
- f) Explain why the seller of the land where the dispensary has been constructed has not been paid for the land despite the issuance of A.I.E one year ago
- g) Indicate how much money is still required until the completion of the project
- h) Indicate when will Labotiet dispensary, a long stalled project be completed?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Health and Sanitation (Statement No. 69)

7. MOTION (Hon. Leonard Kirui)

THAT, aware that one of the functions devolved under Part 2 of the fourth schedule to the Constitution of Kenya 2010 is that of County public works and services including water and Sanitation services; also aware that there exists Kisiet waterfall in Nyongores River in Chemagel village, Siongiroi ward which can be utilized to generate electricity and supply water to the residents; further aware that the County Government has not initiated any water project in Chemagel Village to supply water to the residents; this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee to utilize Kisiet waterfall to generate electricity and supply water to the residents of Siongiroi ward.
