1. The Assembly assembled at thirty minutes past two.

**2. COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR**

The Speaker informed the Members to meet the following day Thursday after the plenary sitting so as to discuss on the CIC insurance training.

**3. STATEMENTS**

Hon. Samson Towett sought for the following statements;

- (a) Comprehensive statement from the Chairperson Committee on Health Services on the mode of supply and distribution of drugs and non-pharmaceuticals to our various health facilities including but not limited to Chebang'ang health centre and Kimulot, Kapset, Chemalal and Kapsinendet dispensaries.

He specifically liked to know the following;

1. Why the said facilities have stayed without drugs and non-pharmaceuticals for more than two months?
2. What would happen with the budgetary allocation which could have been used to buy drugs and non-pharmaceuticals in the said period?
3. What plans have the ministry put in place to ensure that the supply of drugs in future is not irregular.

**The statement was committed to the committee on Health and Sanitation which was given 14 days to respond to the statement.**

- (b) Comprehensive statement from the Chairperson Committee on Education, Youth and Sports concerning the construction of six Early Childhood Development (ECD) centers in Kimulot Ward during the 2014/2015 financial year. The said ECD centres had been allocated Kenya Shillings 933,000. I would therefore like to know the following;

- (1) Why Kimulot, Kibitgoi, Chamalal and Kapsengere ECD centres was each given KSh.300, 000? And what happened to the remaining Ksh.633, 000 each?

- (2) Why Beekab Areret and Saptet ECD centers were not awarded any money yet they were among the identified centres in Kimulot Ward?
- (3) Where is Ksh.933, 000 which were awarded to each of the two centers(Beekab Areret and Saptet ECD centres)?
- (4) Whether the said funds for the six ECD centers were factored in the current financial year as commitments carried forward?

**The statement was committed to the committee on Education, Youth and sports which was given 14 days to respond.**

- (c) On the statement for purchase of buses for various schools and learning institutions which had been sought by Hon. Robert Serbai on 28/7/2015 , the Hon. Speaker directed that the Education, Youth, Sports and Vocational Training Committee Vice-Chairperson be given a further 14 days to respond to the statement.
- (d) The Chairperson on Infrastructure responded to a statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on the 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2016.

Hon. Leonard Kirui stated that he was not satisfied and was ready to look for more information to substantiate the use of funds in disaster management for the *Elnino* rains.

The Deputy Speaker directed that the Infrastructure Committee be given a further 7 days to bring a comprehensive response to the House on the mentioned statement since the response was not satisfactory.

- (e) The Chairperson Committee on Urban Planning gave a response on the statement sought by Hon. Joyce Korir on 25/11/2015 concerning markets which had been constructed in the county including those constructed in Bomet Town, Sotik Town and Mogogosiek market centre.

Hon. Julius Korir on behalf of Hon.Joyce Korir stated that he was satisfied with the response.

The Statement response was satisfactory and therefore dispensed off with.

- (f) On the statement sought by Hon. Stephen Changmorik on the 17<sup>th</sup> of February 2016 from the Chairperson committee on Lands, Urban Planning and Housing on what steps the County Executive had taken to solve the environmental pollution which had been caused by an overflow of sewage in Longisa Hospital and Longisa town, the statement was deferred to the following week on Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2016.
