5. STATEMENTS

The following statement was due;

1. Comprehensive Statement sought by Hon. Wesley kiprotich on 4th November, 2020 from the chairperson, committee on Urban Planning, Lands and Housing concerning the status of leases by the Multinational Tea Companies within Bomet County including but not limited to Unilever, Sotik Tea, Finlays (K), George Williamson, KHMCS and any other similar entity within the County. In the statement the Chairperson should;

- a) Provide the status of the leases held by the Multinational Tea Companies
- b) If any leases stated in (a) above expired and renewed, then who gave consent for the renewal of lease and whether the County Government was involved being the custodian of the Community land as per Article 63(2)(d)(iii) and 3 of the Constitution of Kenya
- c) Provide the total acreage of the portions of land covered by the Multi-National Tea Companies
- d) Provide the status of re-survey of the portions of land
- e) Provide detailed Land Registration numbers of the portions of land
- f) State the amount received as rates by the County Government of Bomet from each of tea companies
- g) State how the County Governments plans to improve rates collection from the multi-national Tea companies.

The Hon. Speaker directed the statement to be deferred to the subsequent sitting

2. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Robert Langat on 10th November, 2020 from the chairperson Committee on Urban Planning, Lands and Housing concerning the status of Kanusin Market. In the statement, the chairperson should provide;
 - a) The size of the land covered by the market;
 - b) The size of the land designated for open air market;
 - c) The size of the land designated for animal sale's yard;
 - d) The name and day of the open air market;
 - e) The number of plots, the owners of the plots, date of allotment and minutes of allotment; and
 - f) The amount of annual revenue raised by the County Government from the market

The Hon. Speaker directed the statement to be deferred to the subsequent sitting
