THAT, aware that Article 11 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 recognizes culture as the foundation of the nation and as the cumulative civilization of the Kenyan people and that the state is mandated to promote all forms of national and cultural expression through literature, the arts, traditional celebrations, communication, information, mass media, publications, libraries and other cultural heritage, Further aware that Cultural activities, including museums and cultural facilities is one of the functions devolved to the County Governments under part 2 of the fourth schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, Also aware that Kalenjin renown Musicians including the Late Kipchamba Arap Tapotuuk through their music developed, educative, developmental and culturally rich music which are in the verge of being lost, also aware that their music records the Kalenjin history, idioms, culture and sayings, Deeply concerned that there is need to protect community culture, traditional musical instruments and regalia and archive educative songs for the benefit of future generations, this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee to urgently establish a Community Cultural and Training resource centre in honour of the late Musician and come up with a policy to promote and protect culture and cultural heritage in the county.
