Comprehensive statement sought on 16th March, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Education, Youth and Sports concerning the construction of six Early Childhood Development (ECD) centres in Kimulot Ward during the 2014/2015 financial year. The said ECD centres had each been allocated Kenya Shillings 933,000. The Hon. Towett Samson wished to be specifically informed on the following;
 - a) Why Kimulot, Kibitgoi, Chamalal and Kapsengere ECD centres was each given KSh.300,000 instead of Ksh 933,000 and what happened to the balance of Ksh 633,000 for each of the ECD centre?
 - b) Why Beekab Areret and Saptet ECD centres were not awarded any money yet they were among the identified ECD centres in Kimulot Ward?

- c) Where is Ksh.933, 000 which was allocated to each of the two centres (Beekab Areret and Saptet ECD centres)?
- d) Whether the said funds for the six ECD centres were factored in the current financial year as commitments carried forward?
