## **4. STATEMENTS**

1. Comprehensive statement sought by **Hon. Ambrose Koech** on 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 from the chairperson committee on Education, Youths and Sports on the Early Childhood Education Teachers in the County. Specifically the Hon. Member wish to be informed on the following;
  - i) The number of ECD teachers currently employed by the County Government
  - ii) The qualification held by each of the ECD teachers (Certificates, Diploma and Degree) currently employed.
  - iii) The distribution of the ECD teachers among all the wards and schools in the County
  - iv) Whether there is shortage of ECD Teachers in the County and if so, what plans does the relevant department have in place to address the issue?
