4. COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR

The Deputy Speaker welcomed the pupils and teachers from Balek “A” Primary School in Kapletundo Ward.

5. PAPERS

Hon. Robert Serbai, the Chairperson Committee on Lands, Housing and Urban Planning tabled a report of the Urban Planning, Lands and Housing Committee on the vetting of nominees for the position of the Bomet County Land Management Board.

6. STATEMENTS

1. On the Statement sought by Hon.Samson Towett from the Chairperson Committee on Labour and Public Service on 6th July 2016 concerning the recruitment of 339 officers to fill the positions advertised in the departments of medical services, public health and the County public service board secretariat. Hon. Christopher Ngeno informed the Assembly that they had met the previous day and that the employment of the stated members of staff has been determined by the Court and that they have a judgement on the same. Hon. John Ngetich also informed the Assembly that the response was with the Chairperson of the Committee. The Committee was given a period of 7 days to respond to the statement.
2. On the statement sought by Hon.Samson Towett on 22nd June 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Infrastructure concerning the construction of Korama Bridge in the boundary of Kimulot-Chepchabs wards which had been allocated Kenya shillings 14,075,220 during the 2014/15 Financial Year, the Chairperson stated that the Committee has made findings and that the response

from the Executive Committee Member for roads has not been sought since the Chief Officer had failed to respond to the same and that the matter had been forwarded to the Director of Public Prosecutions. The Deputy Speaker directed the statement to not appear on the Order Paper until the Assembly received feedback on the same from the DPPs office.

3. On the statement sought by Hon. Robert Serbai on 6th July 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Agriculture, Fisheries and Livestock concerning Embomos tea farm, Hon.Samson Towett requested for a further period of 7 days so as to get the response from the Executive Committee member in charge of Agriculture. The Committee was given 7 days to respond to the statement.
4. On the statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 22nd June 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Budget and Appropriation on the Implementation of Work plan and Procurement plan by the executive arm of government, the Chairperson responded to the statement and sought for an extension of time so as to respond fully to the statement on Wednesday 31st August 2016 at 2.30 Pm. The following members rose to contribute on the statement;
