4. **STATEMENTS**

(a) Hon. Weldon Kirui sought for the following statement;  
“Mr. Speaker Sir,

I seek a Statement from the Chairperson Committee on Education, Youth and Sports concerning the Bomet IAAF stadium.

In the Statement, the Chairperson should indicate:-

- (a) The Status of completion of the stadium;
- (b) The Amount of money and the time required for completion;
- (c) The direct benefit(s) of the said stadium to Bomet County residents upon its completion.”

The statement was directed to the Chairperson Committee on Education, Youth and Sports who was given a period of 14 days to respond to the statement.

(b) On the statement sought by Hon. Ambrose Koech on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2017 from the Chairperson Committee on Infrastructure concerning the whereabouts of motor vehicle N0.GKB001A previously stationed at Koiwa Health Centre in Konoin Sub-county was responded to by Hon.
