5. STATEMENTS

- 1) *The following statement was due;* A comprehensive statement sought by **Hon. Ambrose Koech** on 15th November, 2017 from the Chairperson Committee on Education, Youth and Sports on the Early Childhood Education teachers in the County. Specifically the Hon. Member wished to be informed on the following;
 - i. The number of ECD teachers currently employed by the County Government
 - ii. The qualification held by each of the ECD teachers (Certificates, Diploma and Degree) currently employed.

- iii. The distribution of the ECD teachers among all the wards and schools in the County
- iv. Whether there is shortage of ECD Teachers in the County and if so, what plans does the relevant department have in place to address the issue? [*The Statement was committed to the Committee on Education, Youths and Sports, Statement No. 07*]

[A response was issued on 28th February, 2018 at 2.30 p.m and the issues were dispensed with save for the list. The Hon. Speaker directed that a list of the ECD teachers be tabled at the Assembly on Tuesday, 6th March, 2018 at 9.00 a.m]

The pending list on the response was issued by the Chairperson Education, Youth and Sports and the matter was dispensed with.

- 2) *The following statement was sought by Hon. Kipngetich Barchok; Statement from the Chairperson Committee on Energy, Environment, Water and Natural Resources concerning Bomet Water Company. In the Statement, the Chairperson should indicate:-*
 - a) How much money was allocated to the company during the 2013/2014, 2014/2015, 2015/2016, 2016/2017 and 2017/2018 Financial Years.
 - b) Why were the funds allocated to the Company yet it has never been declared as a County entity?
 - c) Why has the company not submitted their audited accounts to this County Assembly as required under Article 229(7) of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 yet the County funds its operations?

The Hon. Deputy Speaker committed the statement to the committee on Water, Energy, Environment and Natural Resources and further directed that a response be issued within fourteen (14) days.

6. MOTION (HON. LEONARD KIRUI)

THAT, aware that County health services is one of the devolved functions under Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution of Kenya 2010; also aware that the National Health Sector Strategic Plans 1999–2004 and 2005–2010 required all public health centers and dispensaries to establish health facility management committees to oversee the general operations and management of health facilities; deeply concerned that there is a general dissatisfaction from the members of public concerning the current composition of health facility management committees in our health centers and dispensaries; this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee to organize for elections of health facility management committees in health centers and dispensaries in our County within a period of 3 months.
