6. STATEMENTS

The following statement was sought by Hon. Charles Langat; Statement from the Chairperson Committee on Education, Youth and Sports on the status of the following Vocational and Technical (Polytechnics) Centers situated within Boito Ward;

- 1. Kaptebengwet Vocational Training Centre.

2. Kaptien Vocational Training Centre.
3. Kapsir Vocational Training Centre.
4. Boito Vocational Training Centre.

The Hon. Member particularly sought clarifications on the following;

1. What is the total financial allocation for each of the Vocational Centre since the inception of the county government up to date?
2. What is the total number of both teaching and non-teaching staff employed and/or seconded to each of the vocational centers?
3. What are the key equipment acquired and/or infrastructural installations for each of the vocational centers?
4. What strategies has the county government put in place to ensure maximum utilization of these vocational centers so as to facilitate acquisition of proper occupational trade skills and to become centers of innovation, research and development?
5. Does the county government have a policy or legislative framework to provide for the establishment, governance and regulation of Vocational and Technical (Polytechnics) Centers including their registration and management and for such connected purposes?

The Hon. Deputy Speaker committed the statement to the Committee on Education, Youth and Sports and further directed that a response be issued within fourteen (14) days.

6. **NOTICE OF MOTION (Hon. MARCELLA CHEPKIRUI)**

Aware that Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 stipulates that cultural activities, public entertainment and public amenities including sports and cultural activities and facilities is a function of the county government; **Further aware** that sports play a pivotal role in creating opportunities for the Youth, individuals and communities to play and work together thus creating a cohesive society that is an essential base for a strong and prosperous nation; **Noting that**, there are several associations that co-ordinate sporting activities in the country such as the Lewa Marathon, The Standard Chartered Marathon, The Safari Sevens Rugby Tournament, the famous Safari Rally, the Masaku International Sevens Rugby tournament among others; **Appreciating that** such tournaments not only generate revenue but also open up the counties and provide positive interaction among participants within and outside counties; This house **urges** the County Government to proactively partner with the National Government and the relevant sporting associations so as to organize and coordinate such annual sporting activities within Bomet county.
