The following statements were due:

- i. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Robert Serbai on 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2016 on the current status of the county officers who have been charged with criminal offences on whether the said officers have stepped aside pending court determination and if not, why are they still in office. The statement had been committed to the committee on Labour and Public Service.  
The chairperson informed the House that the executive had not responded and the committee had initiated summoning of the relevant county executive officers. The Hon. Speaker directed that the chairperson update the House on Wednesday, 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 at 2:30 pm on the status of the summons.
- ii. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Changmorik Stephen on 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2016 from the chairperson Committee on Lands, Urban Planning and Housing on what happened to the County Land Management Board since the County Assembly had approved only one Member of the Board. The statement had been committed to the Committee on Lands, Urban Planning and Housing.
