1. The Assembly assembled at thirty minutes past two.

2. COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR

The Speaker requested the members to meet after the sitting so that the Budget and Appropriations Committee could brief them on the County Fiscal Strategy Paper public participation.

3. STATEMENTS

Hon. Robert Serbai replied to a statement sought by Hon. Stephen Changmorik on 17th February 2016 concerning the County Land Management Board since the County Assembly had approved only one member of the Board.

Hon. Stephen Changmorik stated that he was satisfied and the statement was therefore dispensed off with. The following members rose to contribute on the Statement;

The following statements were deferred until Tuesday the 15th of February 2016;

- i. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Robert Serbai on 11th February, 2016 on the current status of the county officers who have been charged with criminal offences on whether the said officers have stepped aside pending court determination and if not, why are they still in office. The statement had been committed to the committee on Labour and Public Service.
- ii. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Changmorik Stephen on 17th February, 2016 from the committee on Agriculture, Fisheries and Livestock on how many dips were to be funded during the 2015/2016 Financial Year and how many have already been funded.

The statement had been Committed to the committee on Agriculture, Fisheries and Livestock

- iii. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Reuben Langat on 16th February, 2016 on the steps that have been taken by the County Executive to minimize future losses by dairy farmers. The said farmers recently lost to a tune of 4 Million Kenya Shillings due to failure by Brookside to buy milk from them for 3 days. The statement had been committed to the committee on Agriculture, Fisheries and Livestock.
- iv. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 3rd December, 2016 from the executive committee member for roads and public works on funds set aside for disaster management. The statement had been committed to the committee on Roads, Public Works and Infrastructure.

Hon. John Ngetich sought for a comprehensive Statement from the Chairperson Budget and Appropriations Committee on the amount of Money which the Executive Committee Member for Finance has withdrawn from the County Revenue Fund Account in the last 3 months and the purpose for which it was withdrawn.

The Statement was committed to the Budget and Appropriations Committee which is supposed to respond within a period of 14 days.

4. PROCEDURAL MOTION (The Leader of Majority)
