4. NOTICE OF MOTION

Hon. David Rotich Big Five gave notice of the following motion;

MOTION OF URGENT COUNTY IMPORTANCE

THAT, aware that Agriculture including crop and animal husbandry is one of the devolved functions under Part 2 of the fourth schedule to the Constitution of Kenya 2010. Also further aware that there is an outbreak of anthrax in Chemagel ward in Sotik sub-county which has led to deaths of two residents and others hospitalized; further aware that if drastic measures are not undertaken by the County executive Committee of Bomet to curb the spread of the disease then more disaster is in the offing; this County assembly pursuant to Standing Order 33, do adjourn for purposes of discussing the issue of outbreak of anthrax as a definite matter of urgent County importance.

5. STATEMENTS

proposed additional recruitment of ECD assistants. In particular, the chairperson should inform on the following;

- a) What the department has put in place regarding recruitment of more ECD assistants?
- b) When specifically will the department recruit the additional ECD Assistants and on what terms?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Education and Vocational Training (Statement No. 71)

The Chairperson informed the Assembly that the response was not ready and requested for more time. The Hon. Speaker directed that the response be given within two (2) weeks.

2. Statement sought by Hon. Josphat Kirui on 25th October, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Labour and Public Service concerning the monthly NHIF deductions for County employees.

In the statement, the Chairperson should state;

- (a) Why the said deductions have not been remitted occasioning the County government to part with Kshs.2 Million to defray hospital expenses for Chief Officer Mrs. Baliach;
- (b) What measures are being undertaken by the County Government to address the issue given that the Vice-Chair of the County Public Service Board is due for treatment in India and has been turned down by NHIF citing non-remittance of monthly deductions?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Labour and Public service (Statement No. 73)

The Chairperson informed the Assembly that the response was not ready and requested for more time. The Hon. Speaker directed that the response be given within two (2) weeks.
