5. NOTICE OF MOTION

Hon. Leonard Kirui issued notice of the following motion;

THAT, aware that one of the functions devolved under Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution of Kenya 2010 is that of county transport including county roads, also aware that there is need to maintain our county roads so as minimize the cost of constructing new roads after a very short period of time; also further aware there is need to do minor road maintenance activities including but not limited to bush clearing and filing of potholes and

minor drainage works in some of our county roads ; deeply concerned that most of our county roads are not constantly maintained hence occasioning regular allocation of funds to similar roads for construction; Further deeply concerned that there is a huge population of our youth who can be engaged by our county government to maintain these roads using a program similar to the “*kazi mtaani*” programme, this County Assembly urges the county government of Bomet to establish the County roads maintenance office so as to engage road maintenance assistants or casuals so as to carry out regular maintenance of our county roads through bush clearing, filling of pot holes and minor drainage works.

6. STATEMENTS

Hon. Robert Serbai sought a comprehensive statement from the Chairperson Committee on Agriculture, Fisheries and Livestock concerning the employees of Embomos Tea Farm. In the statement, the chairperson should state:

- (1) Why the employees in the said farm have not been paid their dues for the last three months
- (2) Why the said employees have not been provided with protective gear
- (3) Why there are no toilets/latrines to be used by the said employees while working in the farm.

The Hon Speaker directed the Chairperson Committee on Agriculture, Fisheries and Livestock to give a response within 7 days.
