5. STATEMENTS

- 1) Hon. Marcella Chepkirui sought a comprehensive statement from the Chairperson Committee on Labour and Public Service concerning the County internship programme within the County. In the statement, the chairperson should;

1. Indicate the number of interns engaged by the County Government in the Financial years 2020/2021 and 2021/2022 respectively.
2. Considering, the County Assembly approved budgets of Ksh 9 Million in the Financial year 2020/2021 and kshs 18 Million in the Financial year 2021/2022, explain why the interns have not been paid their stipends since may, 2021.
3. Indicate when the interns will be paid by the County Government

The Hon. Speaker directed the Committee on Labour and Public Service to respond within 14 days.

2) Hon Leonard Kirui sought for comprehensive statement from the Chairperson Committee on Infrastructure (Roads, Transport and Public Works) concerning the County Road maintenance funds which were meant for engaging the locals including youths in the maintenance of roads within the County. In the statement, the chairperson should;

1. Explain how Kshs 24,819,776 which was budgeted under **vote head 3110504- maintenance of roads (implementation of the Roads Policy)** for County road maintenance in the Financial Year 2020/2021 was spent?
2. Specify the number of locals including youths who were engaged under the said program during the FY 2020/2021.
3. Aware that there were committees comprising of locals who were tasked with supervising road maintenance in their respective areas, state why the members of the said Committees have never been paid allowances to date.
4. State the status and the fate of the said Committees.

The Hon. Speaker directed the Committee on Infrastructure (Roads, Transport and Public Works) to respond within 14 days.
